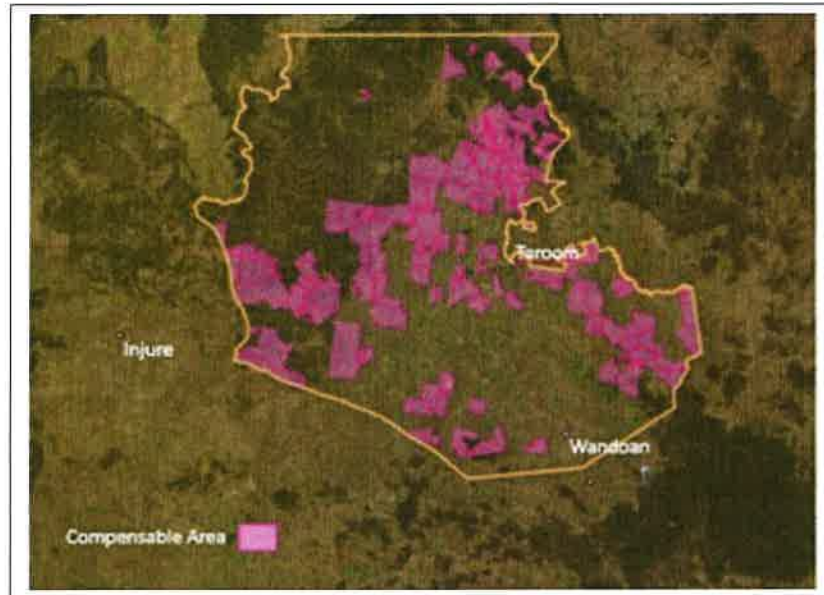


NOTICE OF MEETING

NATIVE TITLE COMPENSATION for the Iman People

As a result of negotiations between the Wardingarri RNTBC and the Queensland Government, agreement has been reached for an interim payment as partial compensation for past acts that have extinguished Native Title in respect to the Iman People #2 Determination Area.

The parcels of land to which the payment relates are depicted on the map below as the Compensation Area.



The interim payment is without prejudice to ongoing negotiations to completely settle the Iman People's compensation entitlement and will be deducted from the full entitlement finally agreed as payable.

It is contemplated that the interim payment will be paid into the Iman People's Native Title Charitable Trust.

An Indigenous Land Use Agreement (ILUA) has been proposed and the meeting of the Iman Native Title Holders is to be held to authorise it. Iman people are invited to attend whether or not they are members of the PBC. Meeting details are:

The ILUA will bind all Iman Native Title Holders in respect to the amount of the interim payment.

Representatives from the Native Title Compensation Unit of the State Government will be in attendance and the Iman Native Title Lawyer will be on hand to report and answer your questions.

Morning tea and lunch will be provided.
